**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BEN HILL COUNTY,
GEORGIA AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF TWO TRANSPORT VANS**

WHEREAS, in order to follow social distancing recommendations due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Ben Hill County 4-H group needs an additional van to transport the group to various events; and

WHEREAS, Ben Hill County previously served dinners to Senior Citizens both in-person and via delivery to home-bound individuals; and

WHEREAS, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Ben Hill County no longer serves meals to Senior Citizens in person, but instead all meals are delivered to the Senior Citizens; and

WHEREAS Ben Hill County needs an additional van because of this increase in delivering dinners to Senior Citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Ben Hill County Manager previously ordered two 2021 transport vans from Irwin County Motors Inc., which was confirmed on June 11, 2021: and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Ben Hill County that it approves of the necessity of the purchase of two transport vans in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.
