MANUFACTURD HOME SETUP PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

NOTE: To locate or move a manufactured home Ben Hill County requires the home to have a HUD certification tag attached.

- 1. Submit verification by deed or plat where home is to be located with the Homeowner's name and contact information. If you do not own the land a notarized letter is required form the landowner giving approval to locate the M/H on the property. (Clerk of Court 229-426-5135)
- 2. Property must be zoned for manufactured / mobile homes.
- 3. You must have a *911 address assigned*; Form available at BHC Building & Zoning office, or on the Ben Hill County website Forms

THE ADDRESS MUST BE ASSIGNED BEFORE PERMITTING! ADDRESS POSTED AT THE PROPERTY FOR FINAL INSPECTION!

4. A setup permit is required <u>before</u> a mobile home is moved. <u>A licensed dealer / installer is required</u> and responsible for purchase of the permit.

The *installation permit shall be attached by the installer to the panel box of each manufactured and/or mobile home upon completion of installation.*

- Obtain a Septic Permit from the County Health Inspector (229-426-5293). If a septic tank is already there, <u>a re-inspection is required</u>. If you use city water and/or sewer, obtain a letter from Fitzgerald Utilities (229-426-5400). <u>Please set up an account with your service provider if necessary.</u>
- 6. Get a print-out (PCR) regarding your Mobile Home from the Tax Assessor's office (229-426-5147).
- 7. Get a Mobile Home Decal and receipt for your mobile home at the Tax Commissioner's office (229-426-5144).
- 8. Permit fees are as follows: Permit includes Set up, Electrical, Plumbing, and HVAC fee.
 - Single-wide \$135.00 Double-wide \$200.00 Triple-wide \$265.00
 <u>IF THE JOB IS STARTED BEFORE OBTAINING A PERMIT FIRST, PERMIT IS SUBJECT TO DOUBLE FEE!</u>
- 9. A Georgia Licensed person is required for the following services in order to setup your Manufactured Home on any Property:
 - ✤ Mobile Home Installer
 - ✤ Electrician
 - Plumber
 - HVAC (Heating, Ventilation, Air Conditioning)

***Please contact all contractors and sub-contractors before you obtain your permit at the BHC Building & Zoning office.

- 10. <u>Any additional work such as: carports, utility buildings, additions, porches, etc are permitted separately and will increase the cost of your permit.</u>
- 11. The manufactured home <u>must</u> be tied down, blocked, plumbing installed, and electrical connected. Also, there <u>must</u> be a minimum 3 x 3 landing with steps and rails (landings 30 inches or above) as required in the front and back of the mobile home before inspection is done. **PLEASE DO NOT COMPLETELY UNDERPIN THE MOBILE HOME BEFORE INSPECTION IS DONE.**
- 12. A 24 hour notice for inspection is required by the Building Inspector.
- 13. <u>All Re-inspections are \$25 per inspection.</u>

REMEMBER TO CALL BEFORE YOU DIG AT <u>811,</u> ALL TRASH, DEBRIS, SET UP OR CONSTRUTION MATERIAL REMOVED IT IS THE LANDOWNER'S RESPONSIBILITY TO OBEY ALL PROTECTIVE LAND COVENANTS NO INSPECTIONS WILL BE CONDUCTED WITHOUT THE 911 ADDRESS POSTED
